- XDA software can be installed on PCs and servers that run on Windows platforms.
- You don't need to make changes to your Internet firewalls, proxy servers or other security settings as XDA works within your existing security infrastructure and protocols.
- You can easily audit XDA extracted information with the viewable Customer dashboard or on the downloadable CSV file extract.

Maintain your network security

- XDA runs in the background and sends data to us when scheduled.
- XDA can only communicate one-way with our secure server.
- XDA doesn't let us access your network. You can be confident that your security infrastructure is safe and will continue to protect you from viruses and malicious attacks.

You can depend on totally secure service

- XDA cannot read, transmit or store your documents, company information or data.
- XDA transmits only device-specific metrics, such as serial number, meter name, meter reading, supplies consumed and date of the reading.
- You can review the time of communication using the client software.
- All your data is encrypted and communications to Xerox are subjected to authentication. Xerox use Secure Socket Layer (SSL) connection with 128-bit encryption – the same technology used by the financial services industry to transmit sensitive data such as credit card information.

We even use XDA in our own organisation, where we maintain the highest possible standards of information security infrastructure.


